Property tax bills are in the mail for Kane

Tax bills will be mailed out this week to Kane County property owners. The first installment of the bill will be due June 4 and the second installment Sept. 4.

The average tax bill is expected to be up about 1.7 percent this year, the Kane County treasurer's office said. People can visit the treasurer's website at KaneCountyTreasurer.org to view specific current tax information and print out duplicate bills.

Taxpayers can make payment by:

Mailing the payment with coupon to the treasurer's office, in the envelope provided.

Making the payment with coupon at any one of the designated banks within Kane County.

Making the payment with coupon during business hours in the treasurer's office (8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday).

Dropping the payment with coupon in the property tax drop box behind Building A at the Government Center in Geneva.

Credit card or E-check over the Internet. There are convenience fees for both of these services.
